



## BCME call for proposals

The next British Congress in Mathematics Education (BCME) takes place April 6-9 2010. BCME is an event timed to occur between its international equivalent, ICME. The expectation is that all sections of mathematics and mathematical education will come together in a single conference to celebrate, enrich, refresh and build mathematical and pedagogical confidence and expertise and about five hundred delegates are expected to attend. .

This is a call for research to be presented at the conference. Presentations could take two forms:

- Full academic research or discussion papers. These may be up to eight pages long and should conform to the template of the British Society for Research into Learning Mathematics (BSRLM). See <http://www.bsrlm.org.uk/infoforpresenters.html> for details. These papers will be peer reviewed by members of the BSRLM. The deadline for submission of full papers for publication is 30<sup>th</sup> September 2009. Authors will be notified of reviewer feedback by the end of November 2009. Revised papers will need to be submitted by 15<sup>th</sup> January 2010. Papers will be included in the Informal Proceedings of the BSRLM and will be available on the BCME conference CD-ROM.
- Short research reports. It is envisaged that these might report on small scale research projects (such as research done by teachers in their schools or research projects undertaken during a Masters course) and work-in-progress. To be considered for inclusion in the programme, you should submit an abstract of up to one page by 15<sup>th</sup> January 2010. There will be an opportunity to write up these reports as short research papers for the Informal Proceedings of the BSRLM.
