Call for proposals

The Executive of the British Society for Research into Learning Mathematics (BSRLM) invites applications for the Editorial team of *Research in Mathematics Education* (RME). This role is initially for a three or four year term commencing in January 2018, which may be extended for up to three years. A team of three editors is required: proposals may be made as a team or individually. The editors will work in close collaboration, taking joint responsibility for the journal as a whole. RME has three issues per year, one of which is normally a guest-edited special issue.

RME is the official journal of BSRLM and is a highly-respected international English language journal in the field. It publishes peer-reviewed research papers of studies involving empirical investigation and theoretical argument from which conclusions and implications can be drawn for future research and/or practice. In addition, it publishes book reviews and abstracts of the BSRLM day conferences with the support of the Book Reviews Editor and the Publications Secretary of BSRLM.

We are seeking a team of experienced editors with complementary expertise, representing diverse backgrounds and theoretical perspectives. In keeping with the spirit of the BSRLM, which fosters research through an inclusive and supportive community, the ethos of the RME editorial team is to provide constructive support for authors in order to produce high quality publications.

The editors are supported by a part-time editorial assistant. The journal draws on an Editorial Board of around 25 distinguished international researchers who participate in the reviewing process and contribute to the general promotion and development of the journal. In addition, there are a number of advisory editors who can provide support to the editorial team.

Applicants for the Editorial team should set out their expertise and experience in relation to the role, and indicate their views about how the journal could develop during the course of their tenure. It is expected that the successful candidates will be well-respected members of the mathematics education community and demonstrate most of the following:

- a significant portfolio of publications in high quality journals in the field,
- a strong record of reviewing for such journals,
- editorial experience (which may include guest editing, edited books, etc.)
- an ability to comment knowledgeably on a wide range of research methods
- experience of working collaboratively in a team.

Applications from teams should demonstrate how they include complementary expertise and represent diversity; they may propose ways of working as a team.

Team members can also indicate if they wish to be considered as individuals, should the team not be appointed.

Editors are expected to commit adequate time to the role, estimated to be 3 or 4 days per month depending on the time of year, to include regular editorial team meetings and support for BSRLM conferences.

Applications should be in the form of a covering letter (up to 1000 words) and brief CV (up to 3 pages, with publications in refereed journals listed separately) and sent to Dr Sue Gifford (S.Gifford@roehampton.ac.uk) by 30th November 2017.

The appointment will be made by the Executive Committee of BSRLM, on behalf of the Society, with the advice of the Advisory Editors. The BSRLM Executive reserves the right to approach individuals by invitation after the closing date for proposals. Applicants should be informed of the outcome of their application during December 2017.
